ORDER THE EASTER STORY

Teacher's Guide

Read through the order of the story of Easter, while children place them in order. This gives children more details about the story than is provided on the print-out. You can either simply expect children to order them and verbally summarise, or otherwise, add their own descriptions for each one.

1. Palm Sunday – Jesus rides into Jerusalem on a donkey, and people wave palm branches to welcome Him.
2. The Last Supper – Jesus shares a meal with His disciples and tells them to remember Him.
3. Jesus is taken away – Soldiers take Jesus away after one of His disciples, Judas, betrays Him.
4. Good Friday (Jesus on the Cross) – Jesus is crucified and dies on the cross. The sky turns dark.
5. Jesus' Tomb – Jesus' body is placed in a tomb, and a large stone is rolled in front of it.
6. Easter Sunday (The Resurrection!) – Jesus rises from the dead, and the tomb is found empty!
